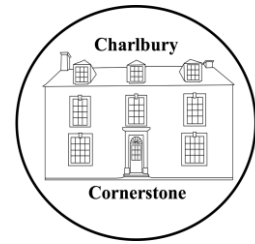




# Charlbury Covid-19 Community Support
