

Youth Ambassador, Charlbury Community Centre



15+ hours per week, self-employed - £16.50 - £18/hour

We are looking for a dynamic, energetic and organised candidate to take on a new role as a Youth Ambassador in Charlbury. You will take over the running of the existing popular youth club and develop further youth programmes and support for 11-18 year olds in Charlbury and the surrounding villages, linking with other local groups and services. This is an opportunity to develop programmes designed with young people in the area to meet their needs and expand their horizons. The candidate will have excellent youth work skills, organisational ability and the ability to support other staff and volunteers involved in the programme.

Contract Type: 15+ hours per week (depending on the youth programme developed); self-employed, one year contract which will (subject to funding) be extended to two years. St Mary's Church, Charlbury is also in the process of securing funding for a part-time youth worker and it is envisaged that the two roles could be combined, making it in effect a full-time position.

Working Hours: The role requires a flexible working schedule to include evenings and weekends as required.

Pay Scale: £16.50 - £18/hour, depending on experience.

Target Start Date: September 2024.

Place of Work: The role will be based at Charlbury Community Centre.

Governance: The contractor will be under the direction of, and report to, the Youth Ambassador Steering Group which comprises representatives from Charlbury Community Centre, Charlbury Town Council, St. Mary's Church and the local community.
