

CYC RULES

1. BE KIND AND RESPECTFUL TO EACH OTHER AND LEADERS
2. BE SAFE AND RESPONSIBLE WITH PROPERTY AND SPORTS EQUIPMENT
3. FOR SAFEGUARDING REASONS, IF YOU CHOOSE TO LEAVE THE CLUB, YOU WON'T BE ALLOWED BACK IN THAT DAY
4. NO BLACK SOLED SHOES IN HALL
5. NO FOOD OR DRINK IN HALL

Youth Club is a safe place for everyone. Therefore, if there are general behavioural problems, you will be given one "warning". If you continue to misbehave, you will be asked to leave.

Warning behaviour: Disrespecting property, minor name calling, mocking, refusing to listen to leaders, playing unsafely, making inappropriate jokes, etc.

Immediate removal behaviour: Bullying and discrimination, severe name calling, insulting someone's appearance, using slurs, purposefully hurting someone, theft, etc.

If you are sent home repeatedly, you may be suspended from CYC for a period of time.
